Note: In addition to completing 33 credits of course work that includes four required courses (REL 112, REL 251 or 252, REL 270, and REL 490 or 491), Religious Studies majors are required to take at least one additional course from each of three areas (theological, biblical, and moral), and to complete a portfolio of major papers and exams.
