The College Prep Weekend is designed to expose campers to training and competition that they will find at the college level. Coach Rothert and his staff of Loras coaches, assisted by current Duhawk soccer players, will run training sessions just like those that have helped the Loras men's and women's programs become one of the nation's elite college soccer programs. Campers will also be provided plenty of opportunities to compete each day so they can demonstrate what they have learned.

The camp is open to soccer players 15 years of age or older, but is primarily intended for those entering their junior and senior year of high school. The camp will take place at Loras, include an overnight stay and meals will be provided by Loras' dining service. Goalkeepers will receive specialized training. Each camp has a limited number of openings, so get your registration in early. Boys' and girls' camps will be separate, but simultaneous.

Housing and Meals

- Overnight stay in a Loras College Residence Hall (You must bring your own towels and bed linens.)

Players who wish to room together on a team should indicate their roommate preference on the registration form. After registering for the camp, you will receive a confirmation email including directions to where registration will be the morning of the camp.

Coach Dan Rothert has developed nationally recognized men's and women's soccer programs at Loras. In his 11th year at Loras, his teams have won nine conference titles, advanced to the NCAA tournament 11 times and he has been named conference Coach of the Year seven times. This past season, 2008, both teams advanced to the NCAA Tournament where the women advanced to the second round and the men advanced to The Final Four for the second consecutive year. Coach Rothert holds the highest soccer coaching licenses available in the U.S.A., including a USSF "A" License and the U.S. Youth Soccer National Youth License and he holds a master's degree in physical education from Loras College.

Loras assistant coaches and current soccer student-athletes and other college coaches will assist Coach Rothert with the camp.
