

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS

Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp - 2008

Due to the difficulty and high cost of obtaining liability insurance, the agency providing liability coverage for Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp REQUIRES the execution of the following Waiver and Release. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in registering your minor child/ward for participation in the Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp from June 9th through the 26th in the year 2008. You will be waiving and releasing all claims for injuries you and/or your child/ward might sustain arising out of this program.

I understand that Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp does not carry insurance for injuries sustained by participants in this event. Therefore, participants in this event should look to their own health insurance policy for any injuries sustained in connection with or arising out of this event. The absence of health insurance coverage does not make Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp responsible for payment of medical expenses.

As a participant in the Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp from June 9th through 26th in the year 2008. I agree to assume the full risk of any injuries, including death, damages or loss regardless of severity, which my child/ward or I may sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with, or arising out of this event.

I agree to waive and relinquish all claims my child/ward or I may have as a result of participating in the Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp against Carl Tebon and his directors, officers, trustees, agents, servants and employees. I do hereby fully release and discharge Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp and its directors, officers, trustees, agents, servants and employees from any and all claims from injuries, including death, damage or loss which my child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me on account of my participation.

I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp and its directors, officers, trustees, agents, servants and employees from any and all claims from injuries, including death, damages and losses sustained by me or my child/ward or arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the activities of this event.

PERMISSION TO SECURE TREATMENT

In the event of an emergency I authorize Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp to secure treatment from any licensed hospital, physician, and/or medical personnel any treatment deemed necessary for my or my child's/ward's immediate care and I agree that I will be responsible for payment of any and all medical services required.

What Can Carl Tebon's Camp Do For You?

Carl Tebon's Summer Training Camp is being held for the 7th year in a row at the **Dubuque Sports Complex**, on Nightengale Lane just off Cedar Cross Road. This past summer, about hundred young boys were trained in the fundamentals of baseball—ranging from offense to defense to base running. Each child is given individual attention by our coaching staff, which is comprised of head college coaches and Loras College baseball players. More important than teaching the fundamentals, Coach Tebon and his staff bring a love of the game of baseball that reflects onto the young ball-players attending. Each camper will be assigned an individual coach who will present them with an evaluation at the conclusion of the week. Our goal is that your child will be a better player at the end of the week!



Our camp work's on defensive & offensive fundamentals daily!

What is a Typical Day Like?

Our baseball camp lasts from 9:00am until 3:00pm four days a week during the summer, Monday through Thursday. Campers need to bring a glove, bat, water bottle, meal money and hat.

Location: Dubuque Sports Complex , on Nightengale Lane off Cedar Cross Road

- 9:00** Registration
- 9:15** Stretch
- 9:30** Throwing Lectures and games (games can be anything from accuracy to arm strength contests)
- 10:00** Defensive break-down
During defensive break-down, we work everybody in all positions.
- 12:00** Break for Lunch
Lunch is not provided by the camp, but our deal with the complex maintains us to use their concession stand and fields. Meals are cheap, so \$5 a day should suffice. Please no carry ins.
- 1:00** Offensive break-down : *Offensive break-down is drills, lectures, games, etc. all designed to increase knowledge and ability of hitting a baseball.*
- 2:00** Wrap-Up Game (varies by the day)
- 3:00** Close camp for day.

In Case of Rain:

Should the camp day be threatened with rain, camp will remain on schedule unless it is supposed to rain all day. Parents will be informed of what decision will be made. **No Make up dates.**
