2007 Loras College Summer Soccer Camps

Day Camp

July 23 - 26

JULY 23-26 – 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. – Ages 7-15 – Tuition: \$135

The Loras College Soccer Day Camp provides a **full day** of top quality soccer instruction and fun!!!

Our staff will place emphasis on each camper's individual technique, while applying skills in practice and small-sided games. The coaches will also teach each camper the tactical side of the sport.

The Loras College Soccer Day Camp curriculum is designed by our staff to meet each camper's needs. Our curriculum will include modified games and drills that we use in our varsity soccer programs here at Loras College. Campers will be grouped according to age and ability level to ensure each camper will be challenged to improve. Our staff will take a developmental approach to learning that will allow for skill development in less experienced campers and technical refinement in experienced campers.

Campers will also enjoy various competitions and camp will feature daily "cooling off time" in the Loras swimming pool and daily lunch in the Loras Cafeteria. Campers will receive a camp T-shirt and evaluation at the end of the week.

High School Training

TUESDAYS & THURSDAYS – JUNE 12-AUG. 2 – 7:00-8:30 a.m. – Ages: Entering 8th-12th grade – Tuition: \$135

The Loras Summer High School Soccer Academy offers local male and female high school soccer players a chance to build off their high school season and to develop their game even further for the future. The Academy features training sessions every Tuesday and Thursday morning (Fourth of July week is off) from June 12-August 2. This will allow the training sessions to fit into the busy summer schedule of high school students. The clinic will provide personalized technical and tactical instruction and soccer specific fitness conditioning. This is an opportunity to develop and enhance soccer skills as well as knowledge of the game, and help each participant become an elite player. All participants will receive a t-shirt.

Mini-Kickers

MONDAYS & WEDNESDAYS – JULY 23-AUG. 8 – 6:00-7:00 p.m. – Ages 4-6 – Tuition: \$40

Introduce your child to the beautiful game of soccer through our non-competitive Mini-Kickers program. Fun games and activities will be used to teach soccer skills, socialization, team work and physical activity. Mini-Kickers will provide a fun and positive interaction in a nurturing environment. Parents will be encouraged to participate with their child. All Mini-Kickers will receive a t-shirt. Children and adults must be prepared to have fun!!!

Team Camp

AS SCHEDULED WITH COACHING STAFF – Tuition: \$35 per team member

The Loras College Team Camp will provide any area team with instruction from the most qualified and successful soccer coaches in the Tri-States. Our staff will work with team coaches to determine team needs, then hold four training sessions (1 1/2 hours each). The times, dates and location of these practice sessions (May 1-August 18) will be mutually agreed upon by the Loras Staff and the Team. Contact Coach Rothert to set up a camp for your team.

Camp Information

FACILITIES: The camps will take place at the Loras College Soccer Fields (Faber Clark Field and the newly renovated Rock Bowl Stadium). For the Day Camp—"Cooling Off" will take place at Loras' San Jose Pool and be monitored by certified lifeguards. Daily check in/pick-up and camp rain site is Loras' Graber Sports Center.

WHO: Area youth soccer players looking to improve and have fun! Campers will be divided into groups based on experience, age and ability to ensure a beneficial training environment. See specific camp description above for age requirements.

WHAT TO BRING: Come dressed and ready to play soccer. Bring cleats, tennis shoes (in case of inclement weather) and a soccer ball. Shin guards are required. Day Campers need to bring a swimsuit and towel for swimming.

LUNCH (DAY CAMP ONLY): For Day Camp, lunch each day provided in the Loras Cafeteria and is included in tuition.

FAMILY DISCOUNTS (ALL CAMPS): There is a discount for families with more than one child attending the same camp. For Day Camp and High School Training, discount is \$15 per child. For Team Camp, Mini-Kickers and Goalkeeper Training the discount is \$5 per child. Please mail family registrations together and note discount. *Cannot be used in addition to Team Discount.*

TEAM DISCOUNT (DAY CAMP ONLY): Six campers or more from the same team attending the Day Camp will receive a discount of \$15 per camper. *This discount cannot be used in addition to the Family Discount.* To receive team discount, all registrations must be submitted together noting discount and received at least one week in advance.

CHECK IN/PICK-UP (ALL CAMPS): Daily check-in/pick up in Loras' Graber Sports Center, at Cox St and W. 17th St.
